When we, the Church, talk about holiness we must understand the way of holiness is for God's people, a called out people from the bondage of this world order where Satan dwells who have been redeemed by the blood of the Lamb. The very reason God calls His children to be holy is because He's holy and we're created in, through and by His holiness, therefore, God is concerned about the heart and soul of people because the soul came from Him and the soul is eternal. You may even wonder and ask why God is concerned about man given the fact He gave us free will. You're not the only one who asked that question. Job asked that same question, "What is man, that You should exalt him, that You should set Your heart on him, that You should visit him every morning, and test him every moment," Job 7:17-18. David asked that question in Psalm 8:4-9. Hebrews 12:14 gives us this instruction, "Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord." The reason we're instructed to pursue peace is because as children of God we're called peacemakers (Mt. 5:9) and only Christ Jesus makes it possible to be in right relationship with God the Father giving us peace with God because we were once His enemy when we lived in rebellion. As children of God, we are created for good works and that work is leading our brothers and sisters outside the family of God to the cross to have an encounter with Christ Jesus. In order to lead someone to the cross tells us we

must be in community because it's the Holy Spirit that sends us out into the wilderness to proclaim the way of salvation. There are some who believe the only way to live holy is to remove themselves from community and live in isolation. If you're from that camp the question becomes who will see God's transforming power at work in you and who will hear? As children of God, we're a transformed people shaped daily by God's hand that carries His presence to people in bondage because He desires none perish but all come to repentance. God created man to be with Him not separated from Him. Do you and I love our neighbors enough to live the life that points to God love a love that's available to and for all that calls on the name of the Lord Jesus. God is faithful to Himself and His creation and He will complete what He started and He invites us to be His living witnesses as He says come to me all who are weary and heavy laden.
